viewed by others.



Grant Writing Tip #1

Have you heard of DonorsChoose? It is probably the most painless way to get much needed items into the hands of your students. Here's a list of reasons why I choose to use DonorsChoose.

- ✓ It's available when you need it. There is no window or deadline for applying.
- They buy and send the materials directly to your classroom. You don't have to make the purchase, save receipts, and justify your spending.
- The streamlined feedback process makes it easy to share the impact that donors have made on your class. This makes it even more likely that they will donate again.
